



# VALLES CALDERA NATIONAL PRESERVE

## Annual Commercial Recreation Use Permit

### Fishing Guide - Requirements

Guides will, pay an annual fee and provide liability insurance naming the Valles Caldera Trust as additional insured, along with meeting other additional criteria set by the Trust. The annual fee pays for guides to be listed on our website. The permit is only valid during year in which the permit was purchased.

These stipulations will be part of your permit to provide commercial guide fishing on the Valles Caldera National Preserve to the public. Before you may operate under your permit, you will be required to provide to the Valles Caldera Trust, the following:

1. An annual non-refundable fee of \$300.00. This fee covers one fishing guide. Additional guides from the same business are \$50.00 each. The Trust is not issuing multi-year permits at this time. No permits will be issued until all fees are paid in full.
2. Proof of liability, workman's compensation, and vehicle insurance. A minimum of \$1,000,000 bodily injury per person, or \$2,000,000 to \$10,000,000 per occurrence; and \$25,000 property damage per occurrence liability insurance is required. Certificates of insurance naming the Valles Caldera Trust as additional insured must be provided. The Trust will accept faxed copies of certificates (505-829-4614). Vehicle insurance is required for all cars, trucks or buses that will be used for operations covered by this permit. The policy must identify the vehicles which are so covered. Outfitter shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the United States and the Valles Caldera Trust and representatives against and from any and all demands, claims, or liabilities of every nature whatsoever, including, but not limited to, damages to property, injuries to or death of persons, arising directly or indirectly from, or in any way connected with the outfitters use and occupancy of the Valles Caldera National Preserve described in this permit or with the event authorized under your permit.
3. Proof of current guide qualifications or letter of recommendation;
4. Proof of first aid/CPR certification.
5. A schedule of prices for all trips/services offered under the permit and a copy of current brochure if one is available.
6. A copy of your business license.
