

Goals of the Valles Caldera Trust

- 1) operate the Preserve as a working ranch consistent with goals 2, 3 and 4;
- 2) protect and preserve the scientific, scenic, geologic, watershed, fish, wildlife, historic, cultural and recreational values;
- 3) multiple use and sustained yield of renewable resources;
- 4) public use of and access for recreation;
- 5) renewable resource use and management alternatives that, to the extent practicable—
 - a) benefit local communities and small businesses;
 - b) enhance coordination of management objectives with surrounding National Forest System land;
 - c) provide cost savings to the Trust through the exchange of services; and
- 6) optimize the generation of income to the extent that it does not unreasonably diminish the long-term scenic and natural values of the area, or the multiple use and sustained yield capability of the land.
